## Intended Audience

This program is intended for cancer registry professionals and health care individuals interested in current cancer registry practices/CoC standards; and treatment/coding/staging issues related to head/neck and stomach/esophagus malignancies.

## Objectives

- Review the nutrition assessment process of head and neck cancer patients and discuss the benefit of early nutrition intervention.
- Understand prevalence of HPV infection and HPV associated cancer and the difference between HPV positive and negative head and neck cancers.
- Establish minimal clinical and radiological criteria to stage foregut malignancies and address common issues and problems encountered while staging them.
- Understand the use and role of ancillary studies in hematopoietic, breast, colon, lung and head/ neck malignancies.
- Address common issues and best practices found across the state of Iowa for Rapid Quality Reporting System (RQRS) and discuss procedures to initiate RQRS for hospitals just getting started.
- Demonstrate ways to utilize Registry data in survivorship care plans to assist in meeting standard 3.3.
- Establish common practices and procedures used across the state of Iowa for collecting follow-up information.
- Share journey of head/neck cancer patient from patient's perspective and understand role as cancer patient navigator and primary caregiver.
